




How to Create Key Fob – Handbag Hardware Australia

You need:

- 25mm / 1 inch Key Fob and Split Ring
- 30cm x 10 cm of quilting weight cotton, linen, medium weight fabric
- A hammer and fabric coaster/fleeced fabric off cut to protect the fob from the hammer edge
- Alternative – 30cm x 2.5cm webbing and ribbon to decorate.

	<p>Start with a rectangle of material 30cm long x 10cm wide</p>
	<p>Right side facing up, fold in half lengthways, press</p>
	<p>Fold each long edge into the centre and press</p>



Open out and fold your short ends in 1 cm to create a neat edge.



Fold again to enclose the raw edges and pin into place



Edge stitch 2mm in down both long edges.



Fold in half to create a loop and place the open ends into the Fob Grips



Place onto some old fleeced fabric and a chopping board (area safe to hammer on)



Fold the Fleece over to protect the Fob from the hammer and hit down to secure the ends into the Fob grips



Check it's gripped in well, if not hammer again.



Thread on your split ring and you're done 😊

Alternative with Webbing and Ribbon



You can also make these from 25mm wide webbing and ribbon for a super quick Fob.



Sew the ribbon onto the webbing with edge stitching down each long edge. Zig Zag along the short ends to neaten edge



Attach as detailed previously and enjoy 😊
