Start combing Op Shops for a natural fibre suit jacket – ideal features include sleeves with multiple buttons/buttonholes on vents, interesting patterned or coloured linings, lapels (collars) and, not necessary but special, if you can find any with fancy stitching and 'extra-ordinary' inside pockets. Also, start looking for tape measures that are coloured to compliment or contrast with your chosen suit colour (for handles). Sign up to do this workshop and prepare to make some handbags that will have everyone talking and you will be recycling with a difference!

TRENDY

- suit sleeve (smaller bag); suit lapels and welt pockets (large bag)

UNIQUE

- one-off designs, totally unique, no two alike!

- head turning, fun and sophisticated, look to include original designer labels and special tailoring features.

- sleeve bag is perfect size for dinner/lunch outings, cruises, great gifts for a young person too.
